Being located in the SE quadrant results in the majority (89%) of current program recipients being from this neighborhood. For those in poverty, transportation and knowledge of available services are barriers. Being accessible in three or four more locations would reach the estimated 2,000–2,400 households not currently accessing services. The top barrier for homeless and near-homeless individuals is finding and keeping housing due to insufficient funds for rent, utilities and deposits. You can help us expand by increasing your current financial gifts or by committing to support us on a monthly basis.
